- Now, the Preference window will open, and you will see the Show **settings** section at the bottom.
- In here, you have to choose **All** radio button.
- After that navigate to this path Input/Codecs -> Video Codecs -> Select
 FFmpeg. A new window will open up.
- Now, under the Decoding section of FFmpeg window, **Disable** the

Hardware decoding.

- After disabling that, get back to **Input/Codecs** section and find Network caching under **Advanced**
- Optimize its value and change it to 3000 ms.
- Now find the Network settings section by scrolling up. In here, you'll see
 MTU of the network interface.
- Again change its value to **1500** and **1498** for cable and ADSL respectively.
- Finally, click on the **Save** button.
- After performing these steps, go to Media option on the top bar of the VLC window and click on the **Network option** in it.
